The Pastor's Corner

RESURRECTION POWER!

What thoughts come to your mind when you think of the word "Easter"? Egg hunts? Sunrise service? The crucifixion of Jesus? How about, the resurrection of Jesus? What does the resurrection of Jesus really mean to you, to the world?

Perhaps we should begin with those who were closest to that historic moment, what did the resurrection mean to Jesus' disciples. This was not just a moment in history for His closest followers . . . this was an overwhelming, life changing event in their lives.

After the resurrection, the disciples had a completely different understanding of what Jesus said would happen after He was crucified. He conquered death just like He said He would. What was recorded in the Old Testament prophecies about His death and resurrection proved to be true, every detail, just as it was written. Their minds were opened to see Jesus and His mission in new ways. They realized just how powerful Jesus really was!

It is interesting that many people who saw Jesus die, never witnessed His resurrection, never realized the power of Jesus, first of all to conquer death, but because of His death and His resurrection, He had the power to forgive sins . . . my sins, and yours!

For many people, the resurrection remains just a story, or a myth or maybe a legend. Critics allow their minds to be flooded with doubt. Then there are some who say they believe in the resurrection, but remain skeptical, not seeing how it makes a difference in their life.

"I also count all things loss for the excellence of the knowledge of Christ Jesus my Lord, for whom I have suffered the loss of all things, and count them as rubbish, that I may gain Christ and be found in Him . . . that I may know Him and the power of His resurrection." Philippians 3:8-10 NKJV

The Bible reveals how the resurrection can transform our lives. As Paul described in Philippians 3, this happens as we focus on Jesus, when we desire not to just know about Him but to "know Him" and "the power of His resurrection."

When we believe that this power is real, then everything else must be like "rubbish" so we can "gain Christ and be found in Him." This means laying aside doubt and walking by faith. We must realize that the resurrection demonstrates that Jesus is with us, and the power of His resurrection is available to each of us . . . right now.

This Easter, I pray you get a grasp on the fullness of God's power in your life. Make His son Jesus your highest priority, laying everything else of this world aside. Seek Jesus with your whole heart and spend time with Him in reading the scriptures and in prayer.

Take a step of faith and believe that in Christ, all things are possible. Jesus is just waiting to unleash that resurrection power in your life! All you have to do is ask Him for it. Go ahead, take a moment right now. Go to Jesus in prayer and just ask, then you can experience the power of Jesus has in store for you!
