- 1. Praise God for sending people who understand you when you hurt, who are there to support and teach you. Pray for wisdom, because God may send you to be that person for someone else.
- 2. Pray that Child Evangelism will be successful in bringing children to know Jesus as their Savior, and have a good attendance.
- 3. Praise God that He still performs miracles, just as He did all through history. He still takes care of us in ways we can't even comprehend.
- 4. Pray for Pastor Wayne, Elaine and their family, for continued blessings in all areas of their lives, even as they are on sabbatical. Remember the other pastors and church leaders and their families, too. The devil does not like it when Christians work together to help people recognize Christ as their Savior. Time is running out for many. Pray protection around all our Christian leaders so their focus stays strong on Christ.
- 5. Think of one or more of your favorite hymns or praise songs and just sing to the Lord. He'll love hearing praise from you, and won't care if you sing off key. He'll be happy with you.

- 7. Praise the Lord for using His imagination and talents to make so many millions of beings and have each one be different in some way.
- 8. Pray for those who are dealing with anxiety, panic, anger or frustration issues, that God's peace will blanket over them and they will be able to hand it all over to God once and for all.
- 9. Pray for all those involved in our church council meetings, that it will be productive and reflect God's plans for our church outreach.
- 10. Praise God for you family and friends. Pray for all areas of their life, especially their salvation.
- 11. Pray for those who have trouble walking for whatever reason. We take it for granted, but it is frustrating to be so dependent on others when we want something or need to do a task. Pray for their healing and patience.
- 12. Praise God that He loves us enough to bless us and not treat us the way we often deserve.
- 13. Pray for the women and girls of our church, that each one will grow deeper in an unshakeable love for Jesus.
- 14. Pray for those being treated unkindly, that the circumstances will change and God's love will shine through to them.
- 15. Pray for the trustees and others who do "behind the scenes work", for wisdom and ability to perform their mission for the Lord.
- 16. Praise God that we can know and enjoy many other believers, getting a head start on knowing them in Heaven.
- 17. Pray for those having a hard time letting go of loved ones who have left them. Pray they will get God's peace washing over them to take the pain away.
- 18. Pray for our troops and their families wherever they may be. Pray for their safety and emotional well being, too.
- 19. Praise God for 4 (or more) wonderful blessings He has given to you. I bet, when you think about it, it's hard to stop at 4.
- 20. Pray for the youth group and children's ministries. It is a wonderful thing to get the younger people involved in God's word. It is important for all ages, but those in these age groups have so much to pull them away from Jesus, that a good base in His word can set the tone for their whole lives. You can make a huge difference by sending up your prayers for them.
- 21. Pray for those who have received a terminal diagnosis (and their families). If there will be a miracle GREAT! But pray they will find Christ and know there is a better future and hope ahead.
- 22. Praise God that He has a plan for your life, that He had in mind long before you were conceived. YOU are no accident!
- 23. Pray that the media will become more unbiased in their reporting and portrayal of Christians, as a whole. Just for fairness and honesty about what we believe, not turning others from Him. Pray they will stick to reporting the news honestly without some hidden political agenda.
- 24. Pray for the Holy Spirit will ignite people's hearts to follow God closely, causing a revival across the land and around the world.
- 25. Pray for those dealing with allergies and severe breathing problems. High heat and humidity can make it hard to get enough air. Pray they will not panic, but be able to get help.
