REIMAGINE THE FUTURE OF THE CHURCH!



It was a great week at the 2022 General Conference Sessions in Findlay Ohio. The theme for the conference was "**REIMAGINE**"! REIMAGINE how we carry out the work that God has called us to do in making disciples of Jesus Christ. None of us could have anticipated all the life and ministry challenges and disruptions we experienced the past three years, yet alone what lies in wait of us in the years to come.

The guest speaker for this year's conference was Brad Brisco, the Director of Bivocational Church Planting for the North American Missions, and, he is author of several books, one of which is "*ReThink: 9 Paradigm Shifts for Activating the Church*".

Brad shared thoughts from his ReThink book on how the church of today needs to be looking at paradigm shifts on how we "do church" to reach the culture of today. A lot of information was shared about the many things in our churches that create cultural barriers . . . barriers that end up inhibiting people from coming to church.

Another thing we are seeing when people do attend church, they are looking for a place that is like "a vendor of religious goods and services." So what does that mean?

It means many Churchgoers expect the church to provide a wide range of religious services that suits their needs such as:

styles of worship music,

preaching messages that makes them feel good,

to have great children and teen programs,

small groups, parenting seminars, and many other things they are looking for.

What Brad was saying and what can be found in his book is that "we as the church must '**ReThink'** what we understand to be the ministry and work of the church"?

Along that same line, a devotional I read this week shared how many churches are being faced with people who are consumers in the church instead of committed church members. Sadly, many are living the life of the "unholy trinity" of "*me, myself, and I*".

So, how are you doing in your commitment to the church and to the Lord? Here are eleven signs that you are becoming a church consumer instead of being a committed church member. **You know you are becoming a church consumer when:**

Your worship attendance drops.

You replace in-person worship attendance with on-line attendance (there are times when people are unable to attend in-person).

Your attendance in a small group is declining, or you stop attending completely.

You find yourself getting more frustrated at things in the church and you are more critical.

Your financial giving and/or the giving of your time declines or stops.

You critique sermons instead of listening prayerfully.

You see church as a place to meet your needs instead of you meeting the needs of others.

You get frustrated at what other church members aren't doing.

You don't pray for your church regularly.

You don't share the gospel.

Any of these things sounding familiar in your life??? The ministry of the church is changing and in the near future, we will be looking at what we need to be doing as a church to be true to the Word of God, and at the same time helping people to cross the barriers to be a part of our church family . . . to be a part of God's Church.
