Mission Possible!

The Pastor's Corner

In the late 1960's, I loved to watch the TV show, Mission Impossible. If you ever watched the show. You are familiar with how Jim Phelps would pull out a hidden tape and a packet of pictures about the new mission. The tape recording would end with something like, "As always, should you or any of your IM Force be caught, the Secretary will disavow any knowledge of your actions." In other words, you are on your own! The end of the taped message would then say, "This tape will self

-destruct in 10 seconds." Which it then went up in smoke. The team was tasked with a mission that in many respects was "impossible".

For my Advent theme this year, I want to take you on a "**Mission !Mpossible**!" Make sure you catch the difference, a mission that is POSSIBLE, not IMPOSSIBLE!

All too often, we allow ourselves to be plagued by fear. Fear of the unknown . . . or sometimes fear of what you know is coming. As a child growing up, when I got in trouble at home or at school, I always knew what would be coming when my father got home from work!!!

Fear can creep up on us when we least expect it. Things like watching a loved one go through cancer treatments, or the potential of losing a job, having a miscarriage, or getting into a car accident. Unfortunately, there is no limit to what our brains can think of that is potentially fearful, some of it legitimate and some of it irrational.

Jesus was born into this world to be a reminder to us that scriptures teach us we are not to have a spirit of fear. Just a few examples of that comes to us in these verses:

Psalm 34:4 I sought the Lord, and he answered me and delivered me from all my fears.

Psalm 24:4 As I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil, you are with me;

Psalm 27:1 The Lord is my light and my salvation; whom shall I fear?

Matthew 10:31 "Fear not, therefore; you are of more value than many sparrows."

Luke 2:10 "And the angel said to them, 'Fear not, for behold, I bring you good news of great joy that will be for all the people.'

1 John 4:18 There is no fear in love, but perfect love casts out fear. And there are many more!

My messages the past few weeks have been on Focused Prayer! Focused prayer is the key keep you from having a spirit of fear.




