LIVING IN A WORLD OF STAY....



Living in a World of Chaos! Many things seem to be getting worse in the world we live in . . . but there is great HOPE that comes from knowing Jesus as our Lord and Savior!!!

I hope you have been challenged by the messages in this series. So far I shared that we need to:

- Stay Confident The Apostle Paul gave words of encouragement to Timothy (2 Timothy 4:1-8) that we are living in times when people will not be interested in things of God but only things of this chaotic world. We must remain confident in our faith in the Lord and be diligent in sharing our faith story with others so more people might come to know Jesus as Lord and Savior.
- Stay Constructive The world we live in is in a time of tearing down everything that is good, many values our forefathers built our country upon, especially things that relate to the Word of God and the Christian faith. Again I shared from the words of Apostle Paul to Timothy in 2 Timothy 3:1-5, warning us of the difficult days ahead. We must be about the business of "Constructing" . . . building strong, positive relationships with God and other believers.
- Stay Committed The writer of Hebrews (10:22-25) teaches us to "spur one another on". It is important for us to be an encouragement to our brothers and sisters in Christ to "keep on keeping on" as we serve God and share our faith.

During July and August, the upcoming messages will speak on how to Stay Compassionate, Stay Centered, Stay Consistent, Stay Committed, Stay Calm, and a few others. As I continue this message series, there are a few things I would like you to be thinking about.

- 1. What is the condition of the world we live in, and how is continuing to change?

 Everyday, even every minute, the world is changing. How does that affect who you are and the way you live your life?
- 2. What is the condition of your relationship with God and how are these messages helping it to change/grow?

As we live in a world of chaos, what are you doing to keep yourself from getting pulled into the sin that is running rampant in the world? What are you doing to keep your faith growing stronger? How are you sharing your faith with others?

These are some of the most challenging days many of us have ever lived through and I pray that you will not let your faith be shaken, but grow closer to Jesus through these times. Trust the Lord of the universe more than you ever have before. The more wayward our society becomes, the darker our culture grows, it is a time when the only thing that will keep you safe and secure is your walk with God.

Remember these words of Jesus, "Peace I leave with you, My peace I give to you; not as the world gives do I give you. Let not your heart be troubled, neither let it be afraid". John 14:26-27


