Thomas Jefferson once said, "The God who gave us life . . . gave us liberty. Can the liberties of a nation be secure when we have removed a conviction that these liberties are the gift of God? Indeed I tremble for my country when I reflect that God is just, and that His justice cannot sleep forever."

We have just celebrated Easter, and as followers of Jesus Christ, we can shout with joy because "He is risen . . . He is Risen indeed!" If it wasn't for His death and resurrection, there would be no hope for America today. If it wasn't for the hope that comes to us through our Savior, I would be in despair because of the wickedness that is flooding our nation. I am certainly not a prophet, but I believe that divine judgment is falling on the land where we live.

It seems like Satan is unleashing a massive assault on our culture (but a reminder, he is only able to operate within parameters permitted by God, ex. Job 1:7, 12). 


send in the mail. Thank you for your faithfulness in giving.

- 1. Pray for all the women in our church, for good health and that each one will develop a deeper relationship with Jesus. Also, a praise for those participating in nurturing others.
- 2. Praise God for the way He has answered the fervent prayers of our church in begging for many children and their families to start attending here. WOW!! Did He ever answer! Now, is He asking YOU to help with ministering to these kiddos? Maybe teaching or maybe just sitting in and helping them with memory verses or any other way He will direct you. Do not fear. God will never ask you to do something that He won't give you direction to accomplish. Try it, you will be amazed at the way it feels to step out of your comfort zone, at least occasionally. If it is not according to God's will, pray that the very sad one will be able to pick up the pieces and move on with their life.

- 27. Praise God for Neighbors in Christ and all the volunteers who work to make it a successful ministry for helping those in need. Sometimes it would be hard to know the best way to handle who should receive the help when funds are limited.
- 28. Pray for the new church plants in this country and around the world, that unchurched people will be drawn to them and find out what they have been missing, by not knowing Jesus as their Savior.
