### FOLLOW – LIVING WITH JESUS



Who or what do you follow in life? As we go through life, many times we can find ourselves following different things (hobbies, sports, etc.) or different people. I want to present to you an opportunity to follow someone/something that can be life changing!

I am excited to announce beginning Sunday, October 2<sup>nd</sup>, we will begin a sermon and devotion series call, "FOLLOW, Living WITH Jesus". We will be partnering with many other churches of the Eastern Region Churches of God for this series. The series will help you focus on what it truly means to FOLLOW Jesus in our day-day-lives.

To help in accomplishing this, there are two main things to help you as you participate and grow as a follower of Jesus. Beginning October 2<sup>nd</sup>, we will begin a six-week sermon series by the pastors in our church. The messages will cover each of the core values we need to live out if we are truly going to discover, develop and deploy disciples just as Jesus commanded. The weekly values are:

### **DISCOVER:**

Week One: I will listen to the voice of God

Week Two: I will adjust to what God reveals to me

**DEVELOP:** 

Week Three: I will model Jesus through building relationships

Week Four: I will prepare people to follow, be changed by, and love like Jesus

**DEPLOY:** 

Week Five: I will release disciple-makers to God's calling in every domain of culture

Week Six: I will invest in their Kingdom impact according to God's design

The second part is, **everyone will be given your own personal 43-day devotional book** to help you take what you've heard taught on Sunday and to be able to dig deeper into the weekly value in your devotions. The daily devotions will provide you with scripture readings, a short teaching and prayer prompts to help you grow.

I hope everyone in our church family will commit to be a part of this worship series and to dig into the daily devotions to help us all become better followers of Jesus Christ. I will be anxious to hear how God is speaking to you during this journey, so if God lays something on your heart that you would like to share with me, or, our church family, please let me know.

# **OTHER MINISTRIES**



PAW Packs is growing! We are now providing weekend meals to more than 200 children each weekend. As the new school year began, PAW Packs gave parents two options to acquire food for their children for the weekend. They could sign their children up to bring food bags home from school or they could pick up the food at the church as many have been doing since the start of the pandemic. Our pick up program has been ongoing throughout the summer and we have seen an increase in numbers in the last month. We are now providing food for 85-90 children each week, averaging 35 families who drive through and have the food loaded into their vehicles. On September 9th, we also started delivering food bags to the schools, averaging 130 bags each week. The week of September 9th, we provided food to a total of 212 children and the following week that number increased to 219 children. We expect those numbers to continue to increase.

Our greatest food needs now are items that we use each week for the school bags. These include pudding cups, fruit cups, macaroni and cheese cups, and single serve cereal boxes/cups. Donations of any of these items would be greatly appreciated. As much as we need donations, we also need your continued prayers to help us sustain this program and its mission. Before any of the food leaves the APB, we pray over it and ask God to use it to nourish these children's bodies and to help them know that they are worthy and loved by many in the community.



# **Prayer Calendar**


